(3) (5) Water Supply:

Dwelling units in a cluster/planned development may have individual water supplies or may be connected to a common water supply and distribution system, at no expense to the public. The subdivider or applicant shall provide documentation certifying that the water supply will be protected from contamination and able to provide adequate supply for the intended uses. The subdivider or applicant shall provide the written opinion of a State of Maine Licensed Civil Engineer, Hydrologist or Geologist that the water supply will be adequate for the intended use.

Discussion

The language proposed by Ralph Sweet would:

- 1. Remove the existing requirement that the subdivider or applicant provide documentation certifying that the water supply will be protected from contamination and able to provide adequate supply for the intended uses.
- Replace that with a requirement for the subdivider or applicant to provide a written opinion from a State of Maine Licensed Civil Engineer, Hydrologist or Geologist that the water supply will be adequate for the intended use.
